

**Re: Executive Reporting**

**Council Believes**

- Union Council is to hold the Executive team to account and question their tasks and strategy sufficiently.
- Executive must report to council on what tasks they have been working on.
- A one minute speech is not adequate time to summarise effectively an executive report to union councillors.
- Only two minutes of questioning is not adequate time to hold executive to account by union councillors at a union council meeting
- Councillors should be given more time to question executive and find out more information.

**Council Resolves**

- Each executive should be given a two minute speech at a union council meeting rather than a one minute speech so they can summarise in a more coherent fashion.
- There should not be a restriction on questioning time after speeches, the timing would be at the chair of councils discretion.
