Proposed Amendment(s)

General Elections

Should a member of Procedures or Discipline Sub-Committee wish to actively promote a candidate in any General Election they will be expected to temporarily step down from their position on these committees to be reinstated upon completion of all business relating to the General Election.

Any member who has not stepped down and is subsequently deemed to be actively promoting a candidate by Elections Committee will be automatically stepped down from their position on either committee. Further, the candidate they are promoting will be considered for a sanction by Elections Committee.

Any vacancy created will be filled as soon as possible by any councillor not on Elections Committee.
