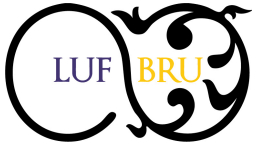


LufBru Summer Games 2009 Rules & Regulations (Rev. 1)

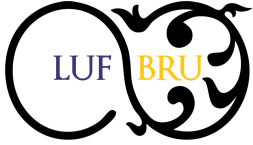
SECTION 1: GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1.1. Participation is open to all students of the United Kingdom and Eire and need to provide evidence by means of their respective university/school student ID card during the event.
- 1.2. Teams will be allowed a maximum number of 'imports' (i.e. non-UK students and UK graduates) per respective sport per team. Please refer to section 4.2 for further details.
- 1.3. Verbal/Physical abuse WILL NOT be tolerated towards players, officials or umpires. Offender(s) will be escorted outside the courts and players may face point deductions to their team/player(s) for any obvious abuse. Altercations may lead to disqualifications to the team/player(s)
- 1.4. All participants/spectators should abide by all the rules as set by the LufBru Summer Games committee. Any unruly behaviour(s) or action(s) likely to cause a breach of peace from players or spectators will NOT be tolerated.
- 1.5. Captains must take the responsibility to ensure their team is ready and available for their event at least 5 minutes before it starts. Please notify any problems to the officials in charge of the particular event. Unless a reasonable excuse is brought forward or any given circumstances are justified, the 'Walkover Rule' will apply to the team that is 5 minutes late from their expected schedule.
- 1.6. The acceptance of applicants/teams are based on a 'first come first served' basis. Registrations will ONLY be confirmed if payment is made by said applicants/teams.
- 1.7. LufBru Summer Games committee has the right to change the rules and format, and details of any of the respective events to ensure the smooth progress of the event.
- 1.8. All participants are expected to complete their waiver forms. Please refer to section 4.1 for further details.
- 1.9. LufBru Summer Games committee, Loughborough University, Loughborough Student's Union, LSU Brunei Society and/or any other parties associated in hosting the event will not be responsible for any loss of valuables, injuries incurred or breakage of equipment(s) during and/or due to any of the event(s). Participants are advised to take the appropriate measures to ensure the safety of their belongings.



SECTION 2: REGISTRATION INFORMATIONS

- 2.1. Registrations for the LufBru Summer Games will only be completed after payment is settled.
- 2.2. All registration forms need to be submitted via electronic mail at lufbru@gmail.com.
- 2.3. The deadline for registration of teams/participants will be on Sunday, June 7th 2009, 23:59 GMT. Any changes to the application information after the stated deadline will be permitted but must be promptly notified to the LufBru Summer Games committee. This will incur an amendment fee of £3 PER NOTIFICATION.
- 2.4. Information on how to make the payment will be sent out AFTER the registration form is received. Payments will need to be done via internet banking.
- 2.5. Payments will be due exactly FIVE DAYS after registration closes, i.e. Friday, June 12th 2009, 23:59 GMT. Please allow three days for those with accounts other than HSBC.
- 2.6. In the event of a cancellation, a refund will be given subject to a cancellation fee of 20% if made before the application deadline and 30% after the deadline, which will be deducted from the registration fee. (*percentage of the registration fee).
- 2.7. No refund shall be given for cancellations made within ONE WEEK before the Games.
- 2.8. No refund will also be given to the team/participant that is disqualified and/or dismissed from their respective events.
- 2.9. In the event of the maximum submission has been reached before the registration deadline, waiting list will be opened. From this point, registered teams/players will then have to pay 50% fee deposit as an "unofficial" place confirmation which is to be made within FIVE DAYS after waiting list opens. The remaining balance of the registration fee will then need to be settled before Friday, June 12th 2009, 23:59 GMT. Failure to comply with this rule will result in the team's /player's slot being given to the other team's/player's in the waiting list.
- 2.10. Registration fees will be the following:
 - Badminton - £6 per player or £12 per pair;
 - Basketball - £50 per team;
 - Netball - £70 per team and;
 - Football - £60 per team.



SECTION 3: INFORMATION ABOUT SPORTS

3.1. BADMINTON

Singles:

The badminton will have a maximum of EIGHT (8) players per singles category for both men and women.

Doubles:

Each doubles category (mens, womens and mixed doubles) will have a maximum of TEN (10) pairs.

*Please note that players will not be allowed to participate in both singles and mixed doubles.

3.2. MEN'S BASKETBALL

Only EIGHT (8) teams will be allowed to participate with the following requirements:

- Maximum of EIGHT (8) players per team
- Minimum of SIX (6) players per team

3.3. FOOTBALL

Only SIXTEEN (16) football teams will be allowed to participate with the following requirements:

- Maximum of EIGHT (8) players per team
- Minimum of SIX (6) players per team

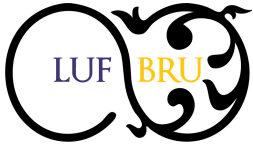
3.4. NETBALL

Only FOURTEEN (14) netball teams will be allowed to participate with the following requirements:

- Maximum of TEN (10) players per team
- Minimum of EIGHT (8) players per team

3.5. Teams will be allowed imports only on the following sports on the basis that they do not exceed:

- TWO (2) imports per football team
- TWO (2) imports per netball team
- THREE (3) imports per basketball team



SECTION 4: ADDITIONAL INFORMATIONS

4.1. WAIVER FORMS

Please be reminded that ALL waiver forms need to reach us by June 14th 2009, 23:59 GMT. This can be e-mailed to us at lufbru@gmail.com.

Waiver forms will ONLY be given via e-mail to the team(s)/player(s) who has submitted their registration form. This process will be part of the registration phase. Failure to submit the waiver forms by any team(s)/player(s) may result in the omission of the team(s)/player(s) from their respective sports on the day of event.

Steps has been taken to ensure that the completion of the waiver forms will be done easily and swiftly.

4.2. IMPORT PLAYERS

An import is defined as:

- a) a non-UK student, or
- b) a UK-Graduate

On part a),

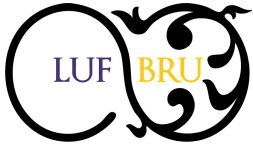
A non-UK student must be a student, who is studying in Brunei educational institutions (such as UBD, ITB, Sixth Form colleges and so on). Proof of status as a student is needed.

On part b),

A UK-Graduate will be limited to those who have graduated from UK for the past THREE academic years i.e. 2005/2006, 2006/2007 and 2007/2008. Those who are graduating this year (2008/2009) will not be considered a graduate as the LufBru Summer Games 2009 is held in conjunction of the academic year 2008/2009. Proof of status as a UK-Graduate is needed.

Teams with import player(s) will need to show us proof of their identity as defined in part (a) and/or part (b) by means of their university/institution student cards (those without student cards will NOT be allowed to participate) or a UK-Graduate by showing us a copy of their degree certificate (scanned and e-mailed to us) and if requested, to show it to the LufBru Summer Games committee on the day of the event in case any suspicion(s)/challenge(s) arise.

Teams with illegal imports will have automatic disqualification and the LufBru Summer Games committee have the right to ask to see proof of identity as defined in part (a) and/or part (b) on the day of the event.
